VMFA-513 Flying Nightmares Ordnance Loadouts

By no means all-inclusive, the loadouts below were primarily compiled from in-theater photographs and is provided to show some of the known loads used by VMFA-513 during the Vietnam War. The Mk.81 and especially the Mk.82 bomb was the most used ordnance, both being used in either low drag ("slick") or high drag ("snake-eye") configurations. Fuze extenders, primarily 36" extension, known as "daisy cutters" were also occasionally utilized on the bombs.
